Papyrology in Israel: A Bibliography*

I.F. Fikhman

Despite the author's efforts, this is not a complete bibliography, especially regarding works published in Hebrew. Some works of "Semitic papyrology", in which Israeli scholars have specialized, have been included, in light of the close ties between this branch and traditional Greek and Latin papyrology. Many works on Graeco-Roman and Byzantine Egypt as well as on adjacent provinces were also included. On papyrology in Israel, see I.F.
